Powercraft Exterior Upholstery

Whatever power craft you own, from a jet-ski to a motor cruiser, new or used, it may be that the exterior upholstery is damaged, worn or not quite to your desired standard or taste. It is, at this stage, that you are probably unsure as to what options are available to you.

The Upholstery Department at C&J Marine Ltd have the expertise and knowledge to assist you with your requirements and options. Wherever possible, an experienced representative will be available to carry out an on board, no obligation, survey or visual inspection of your existing upholstery, with a view to providing a solution to your requirements.



*Whatever your requirements C&J Marine have a service to assist you. Offering various options including, a repair service, replacement of existing foams, recovering existing foams or completely re-designing and manufacturing your upholstery in a selection of styles and fabrics.

Generally, power craft exterior upholstery is constructed using a range of good quality, marine grade, vinyl fabric. Vinyl is available in a wide range of colours and textures thus enabling you to enhance or coordinate the appearance of your vessel. Alternatively, a range of striped Dralon® Waterweave fabrics are available (as shown above) to offer that modern, yet original appearance. The upholstery department at C&J Marine operate a policy of constant research and development into sourcing new technologically advanced fabrics designed for this application.

Whatever the design of cushion, C&J Marine will offer, what is considered to be, in our opinion, the most suitable foam for that particular application. The comfort, shape and durability will be a priority when considering your specific requirements. Different methods of attaching the upholstery to the vessel are available and, where required, compatibility to existing fasteners should not present any problems.

Optional extra refinements are available on the exterior upholstery and are detailed overleaf.

C&J Marine Ltd manufacture and supply a sumptuous range of upholstery, curtains, accessories and luxury bedding that will customise, co-ordinate and enhance the comfort and appearance of your vessel.

Optional extra contrast or matching piping is available. This option will enhance the style and appearance of your cushions, particularly when combined with a design of different coloured cushion panels.

A profile alteration can be made to your cushions to enhance the comfort and style on both the seat and backrest cushions. These "rolled" profiles can be situated for instance, behind the knee on the seat base, lumbar or shoulder area on the backrest and even as a head support on our range of sunbathing cushions for the larger motor cruiser.

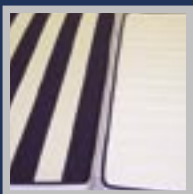


Powercraft Sunbathing Cushions



On some of today's modern power boats and motor yachts there are large unused areas, normally on the fore and aft deck, that can be utilised for those who wish to relax and/or soak up the sun! With this in mind the upholstery team at C&J Marine have developed a range of cushions specifically designed for the purpose of turning this unused space in to a comfortable and relaxing environment.

Firm, but comfortable, upholstery foam is used in the standard specification of the cushions. Other foam options include, when available, harder density waterproof closed cell foam or, "soak-away" foam that when used in conjunction with a mesh cushion base actually allows water to pass through and drain away.



The same choice, range and quality of materials are used in the manufacture of these cushions, as with those currently offered in our exterior upholstery range. Plain or fluted vinyl, Dralon® Waterweave or acrylic canvas can be used if required. The optional extra addition of top edge contrast or matching piping can also add that finishing touch.



As standard, securing the cushions is accommodated by conveniently placed webbing straps and buckles that are sewn to the cushions and then tensioned to a compatible fitting on the deck. Other securing/fastening methods may be available to accommodate existing fixings where possible.

The C&J Exterior Upholstery and Sunbathing Cushions are supplied complete with all necessary fastenings, installation guide and a 12 month warranty against defective workmanship and/or materials.
